



## **Experienced Board & Gas Plant Operators (Contract Full Time Positions)**

### **THE COMPANY**

Headquartered in Calgary, Alberta and with operations near Fort St. John, British Columbia, Pacific Canbriam Energy Limited ("PCE") is committed to our 5Cs business philosophy of creating benefits for our Community, Country, Climate, Customer, and Company.

Pacific Canbriam believes that the quality of its resource is a strategic asset that differentiates the company. Early efforts to identify a scalable, low cost supply source led to a focus in the Altares and Kobes Montney regions in northeast B.C. The Montney is a world class resource and Altares is among the highest quality areas. The region possesses a highly efficient resource development and strong well deliverability. Pacific Canbriam's Montney resource also possesses a high liquids content and overall rock quality that translates into a highly competitive supply cost.

We believe that teamwork is the foundation of our success. We have established a culture where problem solving skills and excellence are highly valued. Individual technical disciplines collaborate to achieve common objectives and continuously improve results. PCE's strategy and its culture are centred on this commitment.

The next step of our integrated approach relates to the planned export of our natural gas to markets in growing economies overseas. To achieve this aim, Pacific Energy has started construction of the Woodfibre LNG project in Squamish B.C, which will liquefy the natural gas and load it into vessels. The natural gas will be shipped to help supply a growing demand for cleaner sources of energy in Asia.

### **OUR FACILITIES**

Our fully sweet natural gas operation is centralized around our main Altares shallow cut refrige plants located approximately 124 kms northwest of Fort St. John, BC near Hudson's Hope, BC. We have a Plant, Field, and water handling division all supported by our in-house maintenance department, complete with a warehouse and maintenance shop. We generate power, recycle our produced water and make our fuel gas. We commissioned a third phase of expansion at our large central processing facility in February 2022 and are working towards completing another phase of expansion by the end of next year.

PCE has invested extensive amount of capital in our water infrastructure to facilitate high water recycling rates and a full life cycle approach to water management. We are continuously expanding our storage requirements and evaluating internal water disposal options to align with our growth strategy.

PCE strongly believes in sustainable development and we are continuously implementing improvements within our operations to lower emissions.

## **OUR CONTRACTS**

The company provides renewable one-year contracts with competitive hourly person and truck rates, monthly travel pay compensation based on location/distance traveled and cell phone allowances. For those who are travelling to site from away, accommodations and meals are included at our private, fully catered operations camp. The facility is six years old and has amenities that include a theatre, gym, and a games room. Personnel also have their own private room with an ensuite bathroom.

## **THE POSITION**

PCE is looking to hire Experienced Board & Gas Plant Operators to fill positions in preparation for our upcoming train four expansion. Reporting to the Plant Lead Operators, you will be responsible for effectively participating as a team member in the safe operation and maintenance of our Sweet Gas Processing Facilities in the Altares area. This is a camp-based position based on a 7/7 or 14/14 rotation, 12-hour shifts; both day/night shifts are required. The successful candidates must be prepared to work extra hours and be on-call as required. This is a safety sensitive job and applicants should expect to be drug/alcohol tested as part of the hiring process. The individual(s) will have the following core responsibilities:

### *Core Responsibilities*

- Daily plant site tasks
- Recognize operational problems and troubleshoot
- Daily production reporting
- Adhere to and engage in PCE's safety protocols
- Conduct work within the procedures, standards, and policies that are in place

## **THE INDIVIDUAL**

This is an exciting and challenging position in a growing organization. As such, the successful candidate must possess the following experience, certifications, and requirements:

- 10+ years of related experience in operating facilities
- Control room experience is an asset
- Oil & Gas industry experience is preferred, however consideration will be given to those with transferable skills from other industries
- Valid 4th class (or higher) Power Engineering Certificate
- In good standing with Technical Safety BC (or able to interprovincially transfer certification)
- Valid Class 5 driver's license
- Safety certification including First Aid, H2S Alive
- Independent Contracting Documents – liability insurance, Certificate of Incorporation, proof of WCB coverage, vehicle insurance
- Plant processes including compression, refrigeration, and liquids stabilization are essential
- Ability to demonstrate computer literacy
